- 13 The reign of Abijah/Abijam (1 Kings 15:1-8); +Abijah's speech and Judah's victory over Jeroboam (2-20)
- 14 16 The reign of Asa (1 Kings 15:9-24) +Defeat of Zerab and host of Ethiopia (14:9-15); Asa's reforms (15:1-15); Asa imprisons prophet Hanani (16:7-10); Asa seeks physicians (16:12)
