<p><b>Isaiah 60:3</b> The Gentiles shall come to your light, And kings to the brightness of your rising.</p>	<p><b>Rev.21:24</b> And the nations of those who are saved<sup>[a]</sup> shall walk in its light, and the kings of the earth bring their glory and honor into it.</p>
<p><b>Isaiah 60:5</b> The wealth of the Gentiles shall come to you.</p>	<p><b>Rev.21:26</b> And they shall bring the glory and the honor of the nations into it.</p>
<p><b>Isaiah 60:11</b> Therefore your gates shall be open continually; They shall not be shut day or night,</p>	<p><b>Rev.21:25</b> Its gates shall not be shut at all by day (there shall be no night there).</p>
<p><b>Isaiah 60:19</b> The sun shall no longer be your light by day, Nor for brightness shall the moon give light to you; But the Lord will be to you an everlasting light, And your God your glory.</p>	<p><b>Rev.21:23</b> The city had no need of the sun or of the moon to shine in it, for the glory of God illuminated it. The Lamb is its light.</p>
<p><b>Isaiah 60:21</b> Also your people shall all be righteous...</p>	<p><b>Rev.21:27</b> But there shall by no means enter it anything that defiles, or causes an abomination or a lie...</p>
<p><b>Isaiah 61:1-2</b> The Spirit of the Lord God is upon Me, because the Lord has anointed Me To preach good tidings to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to those who are bound; to proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord</p>	<p><b>Luke 4:18-21</b> [Jesus quotes this passage and then says:] "Today this Scripture is fulfilled in your hearing."</p>
<p><b>Isaiah 61:11</b> For as the earth brings forth its bud, as the garden causes the things that are sown in it to spring forth, so the Lord God will cause righteousness and praise to spring forth before all the nations.</p>	<p><b>Mark 4:28</b> For the earth yields crops by itself: first the blade, then the head, after that the full grain in the head.</p>
<p><b>Isaiah 65:1</b> "I was sought by those who did not ask for Me; I was found by those who did not seek Me. I said, 'Here I am, here I am,' To a nation that was not called by My name.</p>	<p><b>Rom.10:20</b> Paul quotes this verse as being fulfilled in the Gentiles' acceptance, of Christ</p>
<p><b>Isaiah 65:2</b> I have stretched out My hands all day long to a rebellious people</p>	<p><b>Rom.10:21</b> Paul quotes this verse as being fulfilled in the Jews' rejection of Christ</p>
<p><b>Isaiah 65:13-14</b> "Behold, My servants shall eat, but you shall be hungry; Behold, My servants shall drink, but you shall be thirsty; Behold, My servants shall rejoice, but you shall be ashamed; Behold, My servants shall sing for joy of heart, but you shall cry for sorrow of heart, and wail for grief of spirit.</p>	<p><b>Luke 6:20-25</b> The Beatitudes and curses</p>

<p><b>Isaiah 65:23</b> They shall not labor in vain, Nor bring forth children for trouble...</p>	<p><b>1 Cor.15:58</b> Therefore, my beloved brethren, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that your labor is not in vain in the Lord.</p>
<p><b>Isaiah 65:25</b> The wolf and the lamb shall feed together, The lion shall eat straw like the ox, And dust shall be the serpent's food. They shall not hurt nor destroy in all My holy mountain," Says the Lord.</p>	<p><b>Luke 10:19</b> Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you.</p>
<p><b>Isaiah 66:1-2</b> "Heaven is My throne, And earth is My footstool. Where is the house that you will build Me? And where is the place of My rest?"</p>	<p><b>Acts 7:49-50</b> Stephen quotes this passage.</p> <p><b>1 Tim.3:15</b> ...the house of God, which is the church of the living God, the pillar and ground of the truth.</p>
<p><b>Isaiah 66:8</b> Shall the earth be made to give birth in one day? Or shall a nation be born at once? For as soon as Zion was in labor, She gave birth to her children.</p>	<p><b>Gal.4:26</b> but the Jerusalem above is free, which is the mother of us all.</p>
<p><b>Isaiah 66:11</b> That you may feed and be satisfied with the consolation of her bosom, that you may drink deeply and be delighted With the abundance of her glory."</p>	<p><b>Matt.5:6</b> Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be filled.</p>
<p><b>Isaiah 66:12</b> "Behold, I will extend peace to her like a river, And the glory of the Gentiles like a flowing stream.</p>	<p><b>John 14:27</b> Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.</p>
<p><b>Isaiah 66:15-16</b> For behold, the Lord will come with fire and with His chariots, like a whirlwind, to render His anger with fury... For by fire and by His sword the Lord will judge all flesh; and the slain of the Lord shall be many.</p>	<p><b>Matt.22:7</b> But when the king heard about it, he was furious. And he sent out his armies, destroyed those murderers, and burned up their city.</p>
<p><b>Isaiah 66:18</b> "For I know their works and their thoughts. It shall be that I will gather all nations and tongues; and they shall come and see My glory.</p>	<p><b>Matt.8:11</b> And I say to you that many will come from east and west, and sit down with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob in the kingdom of heaven.</p>
<p><b>Isaiah 66:19</b> I will send to the nations...who have not heard My fame nor seen My glory. And they shall declare My glory among the Gentiles.</p>	<p><b>Col.1:27</b> To them God willed to make known what are the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles: which is Christ in you, the hope of glory.</p>
<p><b>Isaiah 66:20</b> Then they shall bring all your brethren for an offering to the Lord out of all nations, on horses and in chariots and in litters, on mules and on camels, to My holy mountain Jerusalem," says the Lord, "as the children of Israel bring an offering in a clean vessel into the house of the Lord.</p>	<p><b>Rom.15:16</b> that I might be a minister of Jesus Christ to the Gentiles, ministering the gospel of God, that the offering of the Gentiles might be acceptable, sanctified by the Holy Spirit.</p>
